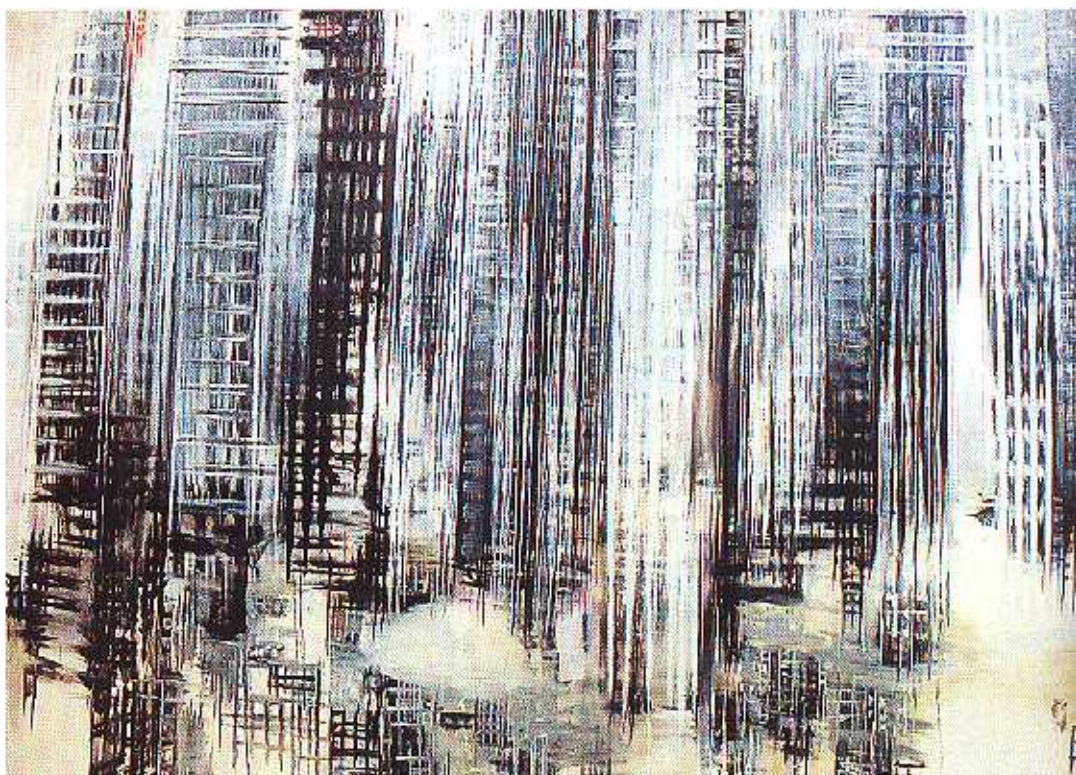


**Eleanor Bond**
